What should I already know?

- Christians believe that God created the world.
- Parables are used to teach Christians the difference between right and wrong.
- Jewish people believe in God and celebrate their religion through use of the Torah and on Shabbat.
- Jewish people have a mezuzah in their home and they worship God at a synagogue.

Vocabulary

Islam - the religion that Muslims follow.

Muslim - a person who follows the Islamic religion.

Allah - the name Muslims use for God.

Muhammed- the prophet that Muslims believe is the last prophet sent by God.

Qur'an - the Holy book used by Muslims.

Holy Trinity - the triangle of faith (God, Jesus and Holy Spirit) that Christians believe in.

What will I know by the end of this unit of work?

- Muslims believe in God and call him Allah.
- Muslims use the Qur'an to learn about their religion.
- Christians believe that God is made up of the Holy Trinity; God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit.
- Muslims believe in the last prophet Muhammed and use the stories that he told to learn about God.
