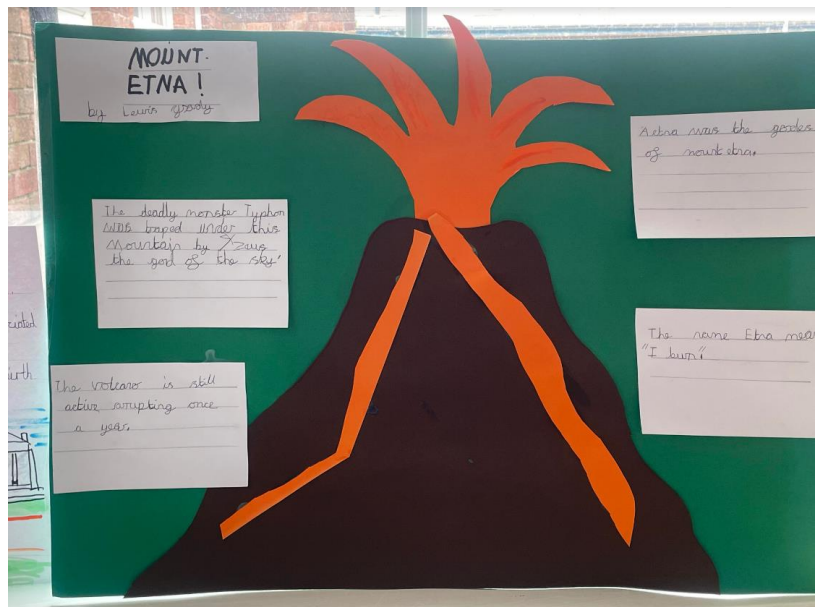
YEAR 2 GEOGRAPHY WALK

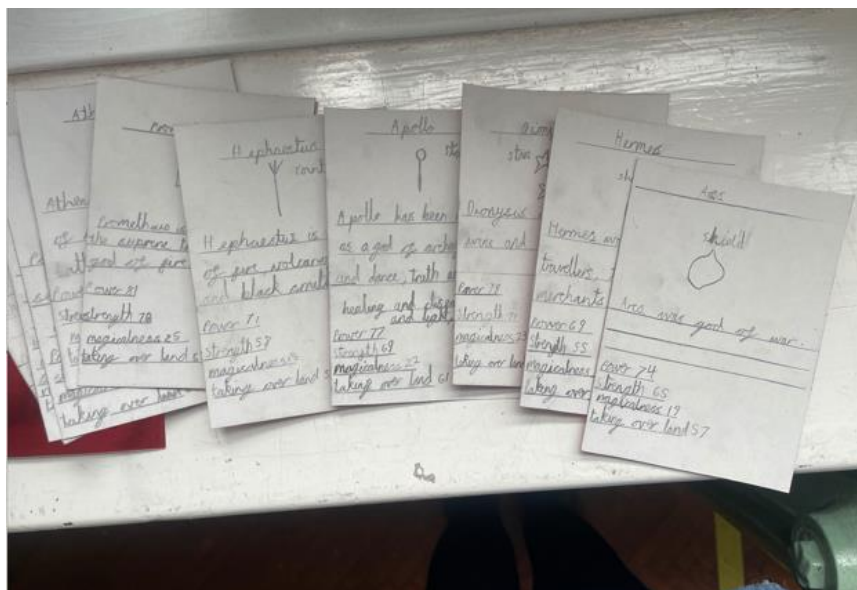
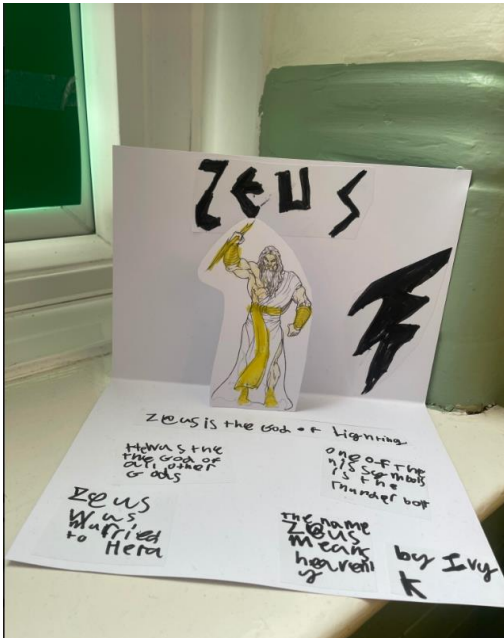
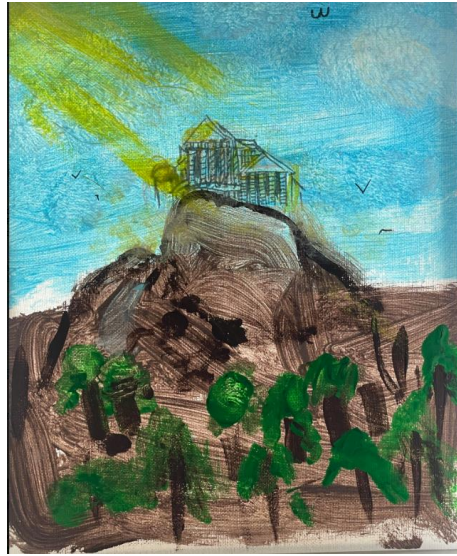
